

School Uniform Policy

Attention to personal appearance helps to promote and express a sense of self-worth. Thus the proper wear of the school uniform is very important.

Summer uniform: The students are required to wear the blue trousers, polo shirt, black shoes and grey/black socks. When the students have PE they can wear the t-shirt, together with the trousers of the track suit, and a pair of white shoes.

Winter uniform: The students are required to wear the blue trousers, cream shirt, cravat, blue jersey and either the blazer or the anorak, together with black school shoes and grey/black socks. When the students have PE they can wear the full PE track suit, with white shoes. Kindly note that only cream, white and turquoise polo necks can be worn underneath the winter uniform and the PE track suit.

If there is a legitimate reason for any item of our dress code not being able to be worn, a note from a parent is required. The note must be given to, and signed by your Assistant Head. A formal exemption will be given for the time necessary to meet dress code requirements, which will be noted as well in your diary by the Assistant Head. Students who have not produced a note are in breach of school policy and must accept the consequences of their actions.
